Itinerary

Day 1 Depart from Toronto on an overnight flight to Lisbon

Day 2 Lisbon

Arrive Lisbon, transfer to the hotel. Enjoy a Welcome Dinner with your fellow travellers. Overnight: Altis Grand Hotel. (D)

Day 3 Lisbon

Start your day with a guided tour of Lisbon, the stunning capital city of Portugal. Just outside of Lisbon on the banks of the River Tagus visit the Jeronimos Monastery (UNESCO classified World Heritage Site). Complete your day of touring with a tasting of Pasteis de Belem at the original pastry shop. Overnight: Altis Grand Hotel. (B)

Day 4 Lisbon

Full day excursion to Cascais and Estoril on the coast with a traditional lunch in Sintra. Cascais is situated close to the sea and traditionally a fishing village. Estoril is a fashionable beach resort situated on the coastline that extends to the west of Lisbon. Overnight: Altis Grand Hotel. (B)

Day 5 Évora

Depart for Évora, one of the country's oldest and most enchanting cities, with a stop in Azeitao for a creative experience: painting a real Azulejo in a traditional factory. Overnight: M'ar de Ar Muralhas Hotel. (B)

Day 6 Évora

Morning, guided visit in Évora of São Francisco Church and Bones Chapel, Diana Temple. Overnight: M'ar de Ar Muralhas Hotel. (B)

Day 7 Óbidos • Batalha • Coimbra

Surrounded by a classic crenellated wall, Óbidos historic centre is a labyrinth of cobblestoned streets, and whitewashed houses. Visit Batalha which became a place of significance upon the building of its magnificent monastery now honoured with UNESCO World Heritage status. Onto Coimbra, famous for its University, the oldest in Portugal. Coimbra's ancient buildings cling to the side of the hill that rises above the curves of the river Mondego. Overnight: Quinta das Lagrimas. (B)

Day 8 Coimbra • Marialva

Enjoy a guided tour of Coimbra including visits to Santa Cruz Monastery and University Library. Following the guided tour head to Marialva. Marialva is situated in a region whose origins date back to the Palaeolithic era. The town of Marialva played a very crucial role in the beginning of the Portuguese nationality. Overnight: Casas do Côro. (B, D)

Day 9 Marialva

Considered the most important Paleolithic open-air art in the world, experience a guided tour of the Archaelogical Park of the Côa Valley. Enjoy a cooking experience with lunch and visit a local wine cellar and wine tasting. Overnight: Casas do Côro. (B, L, WT)

Day 10 Douro River • Porto

Depart for the Douro Region to board the boat navigating the Douro River, enjoying lunch onboard. Dine with your group this evening. Overnight: Infante de Sagres. (B, L, D)

Day 11 Porto

Enjoy a guided tour in Porto. Visit the São Francisco Church, unquestionably one of the most fabulously opulent in all of Europe. Also visit a Porto wine cellar. Enjoy a Farewell Dinner with your fellow travellers. Overnight: Infante de Sagres. (B, FD)

Day 12 Home City

Transfer to Porto airport for your return flight. (B)
